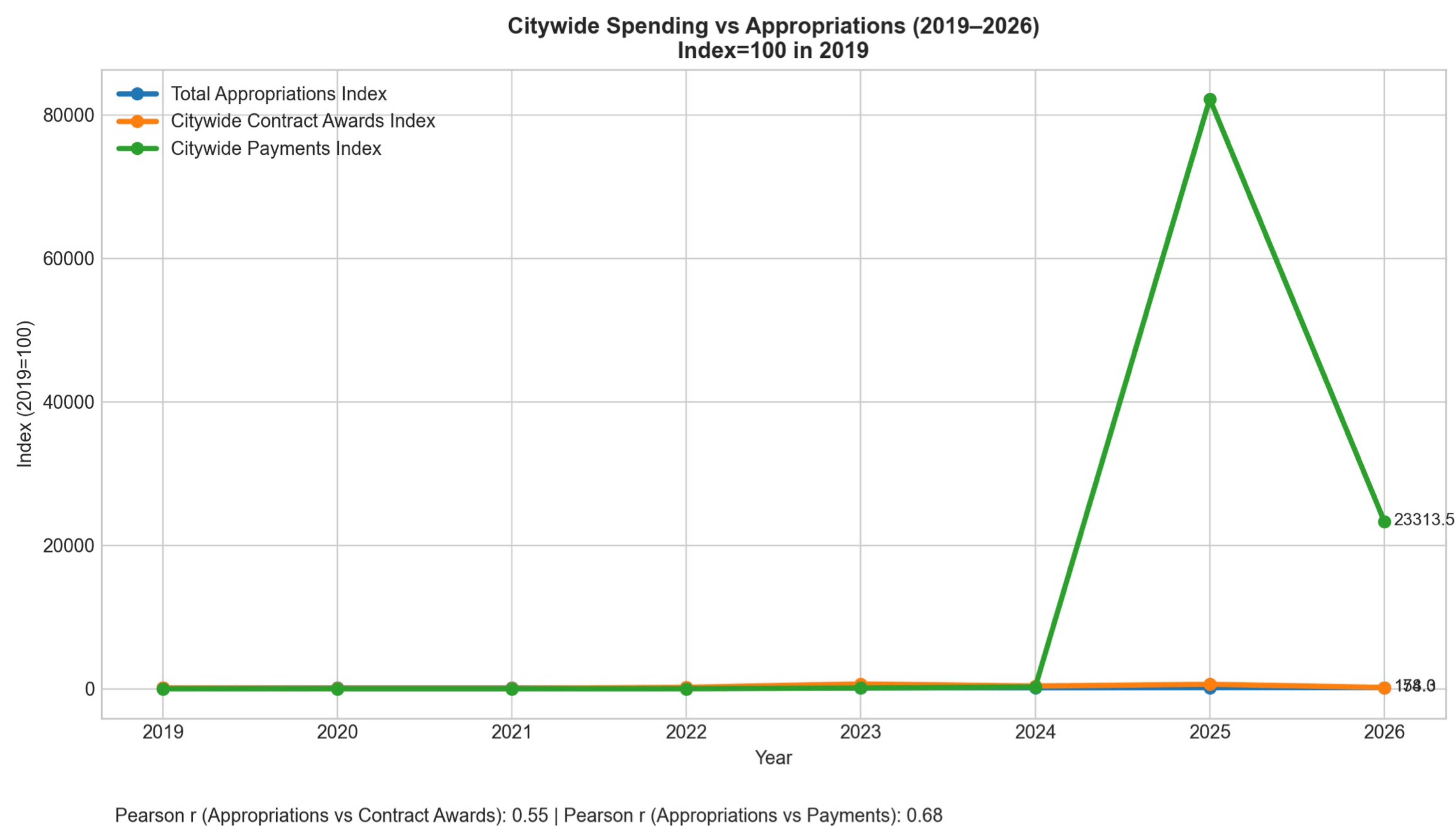


# Economic Growth and Housing Supply — One-Pager

## Problem



### Executive snapshot chart

Source basis: City budget and appropriations records, public fiscal and operational reporting, and campaign policy synthesis (2019–2026 baseline and 2027+ scenario planning).

Economic competitiveness weakens when costs rise, permitting is slow, and housing supply lags demand.

## Reform objective

Support growth by improving permitting performance, expanding housing supply, and tying incentives to measurable outcomes.

## Policy actions

- 30-day permit service-level accountability
- Housing growth strategy with neighborhood compatibility and anti-displacement safeguards
- Neighborhood capital alignment with transparent criteria
- Public ROI reporting for incentive and development decisions
