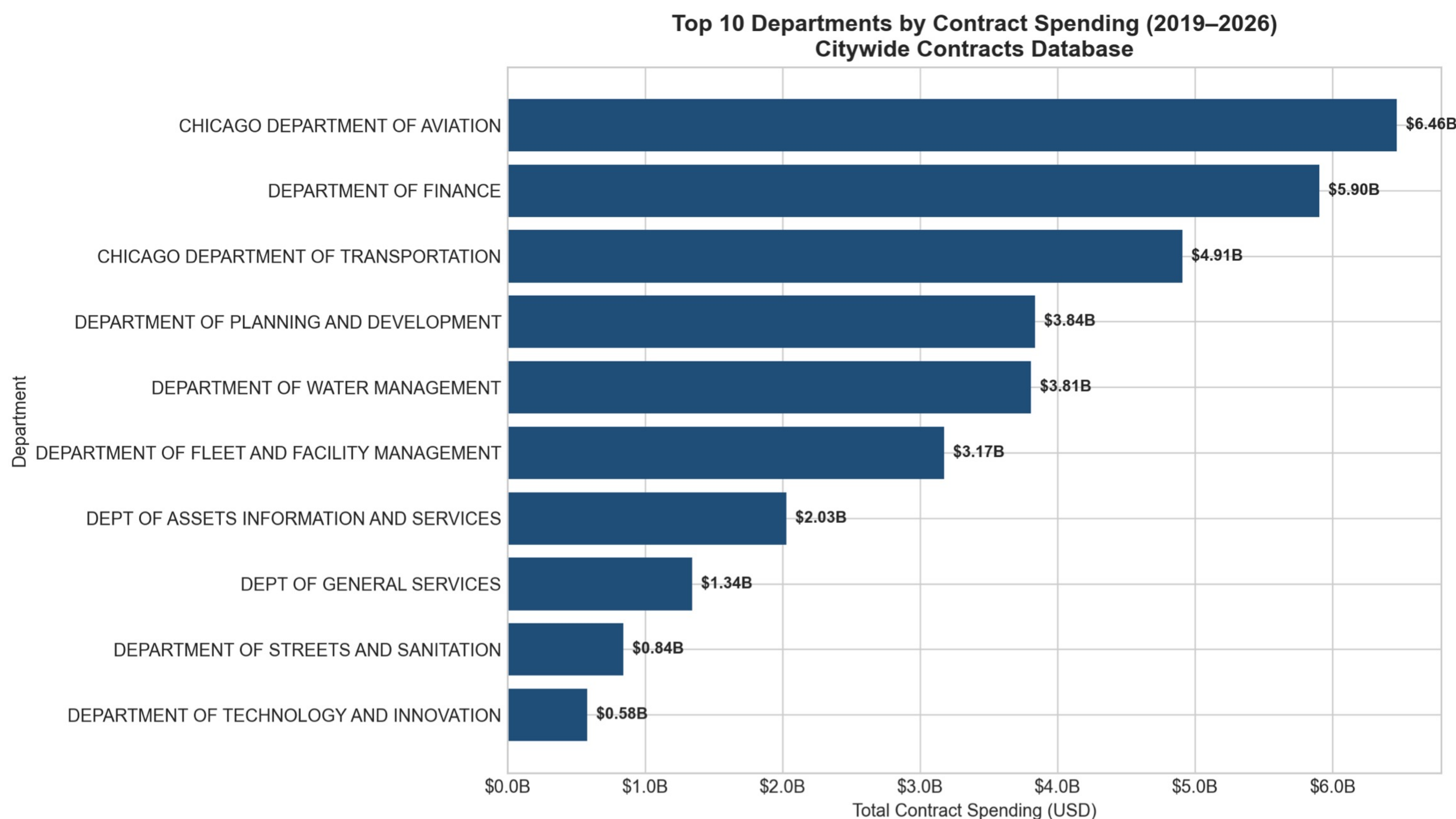


Procurement Reform — One-Pager

Problem

Source basis: City budget and appropriations records, public fiscal and operational reporting, and campaign policy synthesis (2019–2026 baseline and 2027+ scenario planning).

Contracting is too fragmented, too hard to audit, and too inconsistent in linking payment to measurable performance.

Reform objective

Create a rules-based procurement system that lowers waste and raises accountability.

Policy actions

- Red/Yellow/Green triage on large contracts
- Competitive rebid discipline in high-spend categories
- Vendor performance dashboard with public visibility
- Award-to-payment-to-outcome traceability

Why this is central

Procurement reform is the operating backbone of fiscal credibility and recurring savings capacity.
