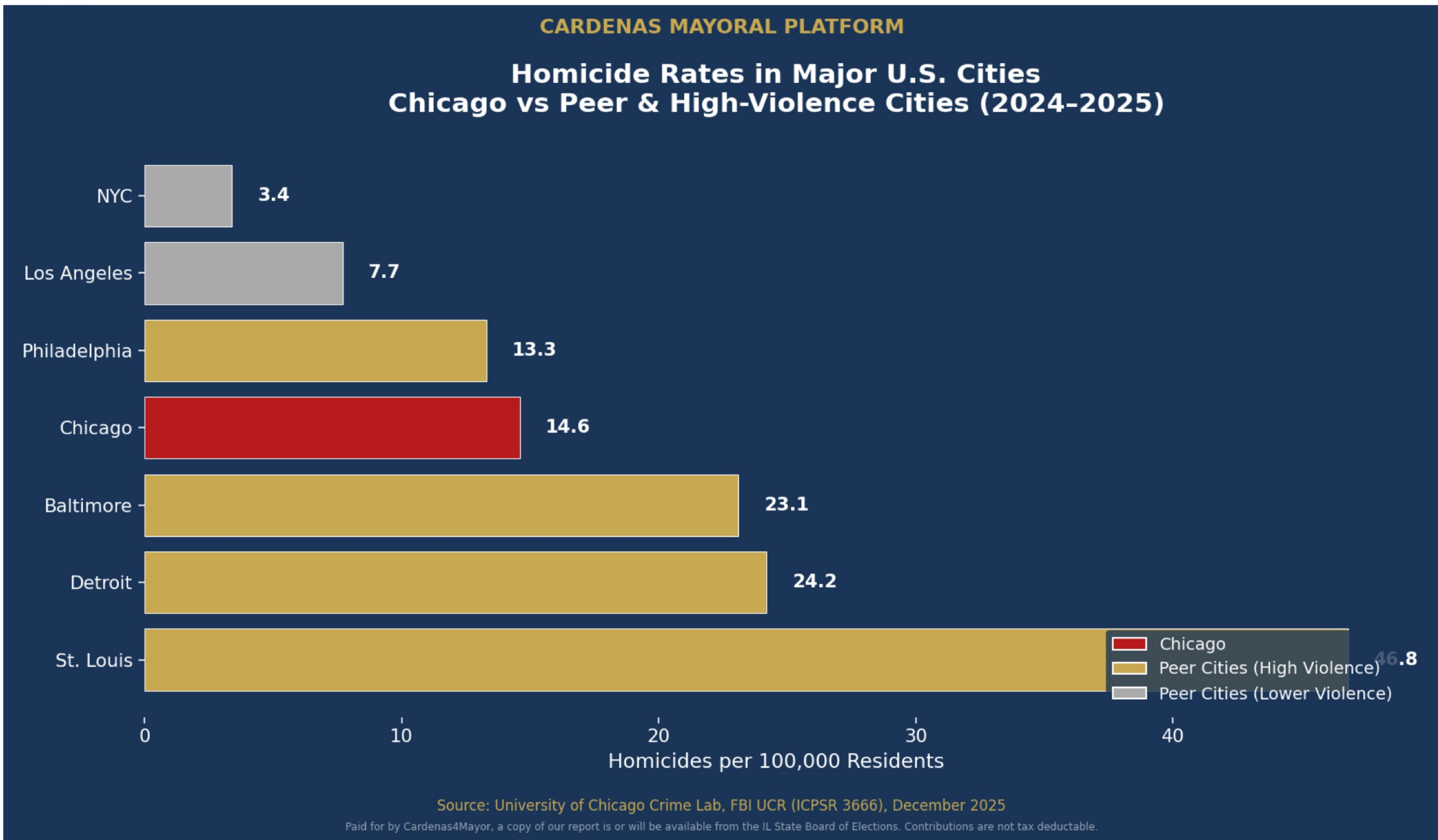


Safety and Security — One-Pager
